- Descendants of Kingery toured the museum recently from New Jersey and were gratified to see his donation of mineral spheres from the 80s still on exhibit on the 2nd floor. They sent a donation to the museum in thanks.
- Recent questions were raised about broken pieces of an old scraper of some kind which were found near the scarifier and what to do with it. Collections procedures will be followed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- MUSEUM 1) Another Yard cleanup day will be scheduled soon; 2) Livery Update enough cedar has been donated to side the building & storage will be provided. Guidi is still working on the plan. 3) Mining Model exhibit renovation is underway. Arata reported a donation to the museum from the County of 15 original watercolor paintings depicting remains of major hard rock mines as found in 1967 along the Mother Lode for the book "Gold Mines of California". These will be incorporated into the exhibit in the Mining Model Building.
